New Indian School Uniform Policy

2022 - 2023

Rationale

The New Indian School endorses the benefits of school uniforms, including the ability to dress for professional success, increased feelings of unity and equality, group identity and safety, dress code equality. By encouraging students to constantly present a neat, professional image, our uniform serves to increase students' sense of pride in being a part of New Indian School (NIS). Every student is expected to conduct themselves professionally at all times, both on the NIS campus and in the surrounding area. We specifically seek the parents' assistance and cooperation in this matter since the children are our representatives and how they behave reflects on all of us, particularly before, during, and after school. It develops pride in and respect for the school environment while acting as a mark of identity for students in the neighbourhood.

Uniform Description

Boys - Red checks shirt (Half Sleeves) and Red Pants Girls - Half sleeves with collar Red Pinafore

Grade 1 to 5

Boys - Striped white shirt (Half Sleeves) and check grey Pants.

Girls - Striped white shirt Half sleeves with collar check grey Pinafore and check grey pant

Grade 6 to 12

Boys - Striped white shirt (Half Sleeves) and check grey Pants.

Sr. Boys (11 to 12) - Boys - Striped white shirt (Half Sleeves), check grey Pants and grey vest coat

Girls - Striped white shirt Half sleeves with collar check grey long coat and check grey pant along with white scarf for Muslim students

Implementation and Representation of NIS Uniform Policy

School Uniform

- ❖ As required by the school, every student must wear a uniform that is both clean and complete.
- The school uniform has to be properly washed and ironed.
- ❖ Boys must wear proper attire, including a tucked-in shirt and a tie that is fastened inside the collar.
- Muslim women are expected to wear the white hijab in line with their cultural norms. With the consent of the parents and the school administration, exceptions could be permitted.
- ❖ It is advised that parents of lower-class children send their kids to school with an extra set of uniforms in case of an emergency.

Winter Season:

- In schools or on school buses, students are not permitted to wear sweaters, jerkins, costly winter clothes, hooded clothing, etc., however exceptions could be made with the approval of the parents and the school administration.
- On school grounds, it is improper to wear sweaters, jerkins, pricey winter clothes, hooded apparel, etc.

Personal Hygiene:

- While in school, students must always maintain a tidy and professional appearance.
- The fingernails of students must be nicely trimmed.
- While enrolled in school, it is completely forbidden to have any body art, tattoos, or piercings.

Hair Style:

Boys

❖ Boys are supposed to keep their hair short, well-combed, and neatly cut. Please be advised that inappropriate haircuts and styling are absolutely forbidden.

Girls

Long Hair

Girls with long hair should braid it properly in single or double braids. Other hairstyles are not permitted, however exceptions may be granted with the agreement of the parents and the school administration.

Short Hair

- Girls with short hair are required to arrange it in half-ponytails, single ponytails, or double ponytails.
- ❖ Hair bands or clips are supposed to be used by girls with very short hair to style it neatly.

Please be aware that loose, unruly hairstyles won't be accepted in any situation. Hair colouring and fancy hairstyles are not allowed. For ordinary uniforms, all hair accessories must be black; for PE uniforms, they must be white.

Accessories

- Students are not permitted to bring any extra accessories to class.
- ❖ The counsellor shall seize and take custody of any ostentatious or alluring accessories found in the possession of pupils. The same can be obtained by the parents after submitting a written justification and assurance that the incidences won't occur again.
- Simple watches without fancy attachments, functions, etc. may be used by students at their own risk; the student is responsible for any damage to or loss of such products.

Additional Items

- ❖ Toys, alitter, games, etc. are categorically prohibited from being brought to school.
- ❖ It is strictly prohibited for students to read any periodicals, comic books, novels, or other extracurricular materials unless they are approved by parents, the school, or they are part of the school's library or curriculum.
- Calculators, pen drives, different storage devices, and any other electronic or nonelectronic devices that are not on the list of approved objects at the school are strictly prohibited.

Mobile Phones

Students are not allowed to carry or use mobile phones within the school premises. In case of emergencies, the student may raise a concern with the concerned caretaker, teacher, or counselor, who will ensure that the situation is taken care of.

Measures to Prevent Misbehaviour

- ❖ The school reserves the right to conduct surprise investigations of the student's person or personal items present in the school.
- Any item found in the possession of a student outside the stipulated school curriculum, inclusive of mobile phones, calculators, pen drives, miscellaneous storage devices, any electronic or non-electronic devices, magazines, comics, novels, extra literature outside the school curriculum, toys, glitter, games, fancy accessories, etc., can and will be confiscated and taken into possession by the counselor. The same may be retrieved by the parents upon submission of a written explanation and confirmation of the non-recurrence of such incidents.
- Any evidence collected via CCTV, image, video, or audio recording from teachers or other trusted sources can and will be filed and used as proof in cases of deviations.

General Instructions to Students

- Students are expected to follow school decorum at all times and treat all teaching and non-teaching staff with respect.
- Students are expected to follow all instructions and rules recorded in the school diary.
- Students are expected to follow the timetable set by the school and carry all relevant textbooks and notebooks required for the day.
- Every student is expected to carry the school calendar and a rough notebook to school every day.

General Instructions to Parents

- ❖ Parents are expected to follow all instructions and rules recorded in the school diary.
- Every message sent in the WhatsApp group is expected to be confirmed and responded to by parents.
- Parents are expected to check the school diary daily and respond to, acknowledge, or sign any communication from the school via the diary.

Please note that every student of New Indian School is under strict monitoring, and any deviation or misbehaviour on the part of the student will be strictly dealt with, and the parents are expected to meet the school counsellor in person to resolve the same and ensure the smooth progress of their ward at school.
